

RESOLUTION NO. 24 - 12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ATHERTON CALLING AND ORDERING A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2024; AND REQUIRING CANDIDATES TO PAY THE COST OF PUBLICATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF THE STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS WITH THE SAMPLE BALLOT AND SPECIFYING THE LENGTH OF THE STATEMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE SAN MATEO COUNTY CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER TO CONDUCT THE TOWN'S ELECTION

WHEREAS, under the provisions of State law and the Town of Atherton ("Town") Municipal Regulations relating to elections, there is to be a General Municipal Election, Tuesday, November 5, 2024 for the purpose of electing two members to the City Council to each fill a four-year term; and

WHEREAS, a service agreement will be prepared and forwarded by the City Clerk to the San Mateo County Chief Elections Officer for the purpose of conducting the General Municipal Election for the Town of Atherton; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk will cause a legal notice calling and ordering an election to be published in an adjudicated newspaper; and

WHEREAS, twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) has been appropriated from the Town's General Fund in the 2024-25 Fiscal Budget to cover the cost of the San Mateo County's Registration & Elections Division ("County") services to the City connected to this election and the Town will receive an invoice from the County in January 2025.

WHEREAS, Section 13307 of the Elections Code of the State of California provides that the governing body of any local agency adopt regulations pertaining to materials prepared by any candidate for municipal election, including costs of the candidate statement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of Atherton as follows:

THAT, the Town of Atherton calls and orders a Tuesday, November 5, 2024, General Municipal Election for the Town of Atherton, for the purpose of electing two members to the City Council; and

THAT, the Town authorizes the City Manager to enter into a service agreement with San Mateo County's Chief Election Officer to conduct the election; and

THAT, the Town requests the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo to consolidate a municipal Election to be held on November 5, 2024, with the Statewide General Election held on that date pursuant to section 10403 of the Elections Code; and

THAT, by the City Council of the Town of Atherton that each candidate who requests that a Statement of Qualifications be published and distributed with the sample ballot for the General Election, to be held on November 5, 2024, shall be charged a deposit of \$4000.00 to cover the cost of publication of such Statement of Qualifications, including the cost of translation of such statement into Spanish and Chinese, if requested by the candidate. The Statement of Qualification may not exceed two hundred (200) words in length and will be the only material sent with the sample ballots and no other material will be included for distribution.

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


