RE: TRAFFIC REPORT –September 2023

The following is a summary of the activities that have occurred during the month, as well as a summary of the collision, citation and DUI statistics for the Police Department.

TRAFFIC COMPLAINTS

There were no traffic complaints reported to officers for the month of September. Four (4) complaints were reported, but due to training, the traffic team was not able to sufficiently work these areas. These complaints are carried over to October.

MONTHLY DUI REPORT

During the month of September, there was one (1) arrest for DUI. No DUI arrests were made as the result of a collision.

TRUCK ENFORCEMENT DATA

No truck stop details were performed during the month of September.

TRAFFIC OFFICER SCHEDULE

Sergeant Metzger, Officer Rojas, Officer MacDonald, and Officer Gatto were assigned to the Traffic Division. These officers utilized their police motorcycles and worked traffic enforcement as time and calls for service permitted.

Sergeant Metzger was scheduled for 120 hours and produced 164 combined cites.
Officer Rojas was scheduled for 163 hours and produced 121 combined cites.
Officer MacDonald was scheduled for 188 hours and produced 136 combined cites.
Officer Gatto was scheduled for 186 hours and produced 42 combined cites.

TRAFFIC COLLISION DATA

During the month of September, a total of four (4) traffic collisions occurred in the Town of Atherton. Three (3) of the collisions involved injuries. One (1) of the collisions was a hit-and-run. None of the collisions involved a driver who was driving under the influence.
