SUBJECT:Review and Feedback Regarding the Report from the Ad Hoc City
Council Subcommittee on Housing – Criteria for Opportunity Site
Selection

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Council review, discuss and provide direction to staff regarding the Report from the Ad Hoc Subcommittee on Housing.

BACKGROUND

At the City Council Meeting on March 15, 2023, the City Council disccussed feedback from the Atherton Housing Coalition and briefly discussed other housing opportunity sites for consideration. Following discussion, the City Council asked that the Ad Hoc Subcommittee on Housing review various criteria that could be used by the City Council for selection of housing opportunity sites and return to the Council wiht a recommendation on what criteria should be considered.

ANALYSIS

The Ad Hoc Subcommittee and staff met during the week of March 20, 2023 to discuss specific criteria that could be used by the Council for selection of opportunity sites for potential housing development <u>as part of</u> the Town's Housing Element Update.
