The following is a summary of the activities that have occurred during the month, as well as a summary of the collision, citations, and DUI statistics for the Police Department.

TRAFFIC COMPLAINTS

The Atherton Police Department did not receive any traffic complaints for the month of July.

MONTHLY DUI REPORT

One (1) arrest was made for Driving Under the Influence during the month of July.

TRUCK ENFORCEMENT DATA

No truck stop details were performed during the month of July

TRAFFIC OFFICER SCHEDULE

Sergeant Metzger, Officer Rojas and Officer MacDonald were assigned to the Traffic Division during the month of July. These officers utilized their police motorcycles and worked traffic enforcement as time and calls for service permitted.

Sergeant Metzger was scheduled for 132 hours and produced 230 combined cites.

Officer MacDonald was scheduled for 128 hours and produced 101 combined cites.


